

Trinity United Church Congregational Meeting
Sunday, April 28, 2019

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss and ratify plans for a new church ramp to meet accessibility requirements.

MOTION: Linda Brown/ Glenda Turner Carried.

At this point the meeting was turned over to Carl Turner, Chair of the Trustees and head of the ramp project. The Township has approved this project and we now need the congregation's acceptance. Carl walked us through the details of the plan and then answered questions.

Carl mentioned that we have three quotes for the construction of this ramp: \$66,000, \$58,000, and 30,000. The lowest quote does not include door replacements, but Carl has worked with this contractor (J. Walker Construction) and felt he would do an excellent job. The financing of this project will be through our Trinity Kawartha Trust Fund.

MOTION: That we accept the lowest bid with the flexibility of an upper limit to \$50,000. Glenda Turner/Don Coleman. A vote was taken by a show of hands, and it was unanimous that we should accept this bid and move ahead with the project as soon as possible.
