- b. At the Annual Congregational Meeting concern was expressed about the poor performance of our E-L Consolidated Fund. Looking back to 2017, however, the fund has grown each year except 2018 and 2022 for an increase of \$ 4,820.38. The decision was to leave this investment for another year.

- 9. We had a general discussion about Rev. Catherine's retirement and the wonderful contribution she has made. We need to move ahead now more quickly with our "Road Ahead" and search for a new minister.
