A. At a combined Session / Stewards meeting following our meeting, we heard a presentation by Diane Revill, Ian and Jane Mackay and Sheila Anthony that outlined a draft <u>Memorandum of Understanding</u> for the commitment of Ian and Sheila to provide us with pulpit supply at least from July 1 to December 31, 2023. The agreement would be reviewed by Oct. 30, 2023.

They would provide us with 2 services per month each.

Salaries will be negotiated through the M&P Committee.

After a final update of this agreement, there will be a congregational meeting where it will be ratified and the issues of pastoral care and other congregational priorities will be addressed.
